The minutes from the November 4, 2008 are to be clarified stating that Duncanville High School Golf Team is approved to play and practice at Thorntree.

Jamie Head, TWGA President, was welcomed as a new member of the Board of Governors. Christian Hughes was welcomed to his first BOG meeting.

Locker Room Renovation Project

- John Cochran of Club Designs presented the proposed plans for the renovation of the Men's and Women's Locker Rooms.
- Gulzar Rana moved that Plan A be accepted for the Men's Locker-Room. David Fredrikson seconded the motion. Motion passed.
- Bette Moncrief moved to accept the renovation plans for the Ladies Locker Room. Sondra Swan seconded the motion. Motion passed.
- John Cochran will get bids from general contractors for the renovation. Chris Hamill of Arnold Palmer Corporate will review the bids and, if necessary, obtain additional bids.

- Glen Smith moved that 2B be changed to read that the 9 elected BOG members are the only voting members on the Board. Paula Easter seconded the motion. Motion passed.
- Glen Smith moved that only the Handicap Committee be a sub committee of the Golf Committee. Bob Libbey seconded the motion. Motion passed.
- Bette Moncrief moved to adopt the amended Policies and Procedures. Glen Smith seconded the motion. Motion failed.
- Joe Johnson is to send an updated copy of the Policies and Procedures to the BOG for further discussion in February.

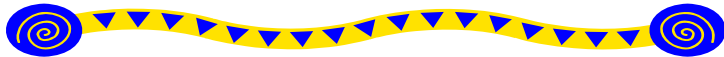

Get ready KIDS! Your Junior Golf Program is coming. This golf season we will be hosting several different activities to appeal to our young golfers. As always, we will be having our All Sports Camps. In these all sports camps, campers will learn the fundamentals of golf as well as etiquette and the rules, learn and play the game of tennis, and enjoy free time playing games at the pool.

Turf Talk



Where do I place the rake after I have raked the bunker you ask? This topic was covered briefly in the October newsletter. Placing the rakes inside bunkers has been the practice here at Thorntree CC for many years. The USGA has made a formal recommendation to place rakes outside of bunkers and pointing down the line of play. The USGA recommends rakes on the outside because they have deemed that they have less impact on play, and rulings are cleaner and less costly to the player. This will eliminate the chance of being caught against the lip of a bunker by a rake that is inside the bunker. S161

With this in mind Golf Maintenance is placing bunker rakes on the outside of the bunkers with the head facing down the line of play. We ask you, after your shot has been played out of a bunker. Please rake the bunker, then leave the rake on the outside of the bunker, and in a manner that will have the least impact on the players that will follow you.
