A special thanks to all the Ambassadors, John Lewis and Scott Carter and the great staff.

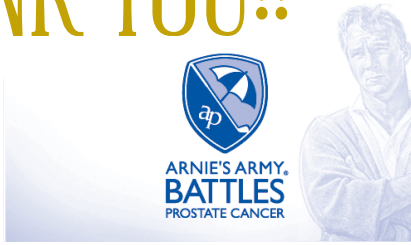

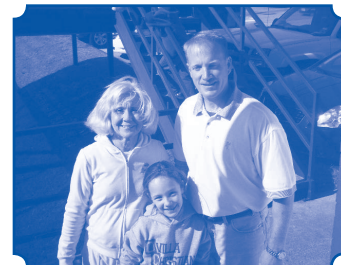

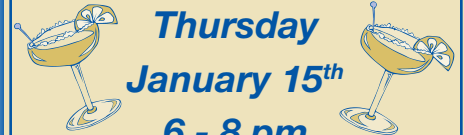
