**The Girl Who Played with Fire** (June 3): Late Swedish writer Stieg Larsson's second novel in his "Millennium Trilogy" again features a journalist/publisher and his young computer-hacker friend Lisbeth (she of the dragon tattoo from the first novel). This Nordic thriller critiques Swedish society and "explores misogynistic men at all levels and the women they exploit." Taking the law into her own hands to expose a slick sex-trafficking business and the corrupt government officials who cover it up, Lisbeth once again amazes with her unorthodox stealth and extraordinary brain power. Readers find themselves quietly cheering for the upright male protagonist journalist - and especially for the secretive girl who hates men for very good reasons of her own!

**The Help** (Aug 5): Set in 1960s Jackson, Mississippi, this page-turner focuses on white Southern households and the black domestic maids who toiled in those households. The white characters range from "politely racist" Junior Leaguers to matrons who openly despise and mistreat the very maids who help them raise their children. Speaking primarily through three voices (regal black maid Aibileen's, and sassy cook Minny's, as well as 21-year-old Old Miss graduate Eugenia "Skeeter" Phelan's), the author writes of a room "full of cake-eating, Tab-drinking, cigarette-smoking women" planning a fundraiser for the "Poor Starving Children of Africa." Author Kathryn Stockett doesn't hit us over the head with the ironies inherent in these 1960's situations. She does, however, get her point across, all the while portraying her characters - whether black or white - with insight and humor. DreamWorks Studios recently announced a film version of the "The Help."

A new Ambassador Council will be established after the new BOG takes office. The Council's priority will be to integrate new members into the Club.

Currently there are 313 Full Golf Memberships, 66 Tennis Memberships and 205 Social Memberships. New members that have been sponsored by an existing member have no initiation requirements. Non sponsored members have a mandatory 15 month contract.

A Corporate Membership must include at least 2 full dues paying members. They receive 4 golf guest passes and 4 lunch certificates monthly. These can only be used on week days.

Monthly dues are down 11%.

Food and beverage is down 14%.

Total revenue is down 11%.

Total expenses are down 12%.

Operating Income/EBITDA is down 4% compared to the same time last year. All numbers are compared to this time last year.

The 2010 Rally for the Cure was a success raising approximately \$12,000 for Susan G. Komen.

MGA, Gulzar Rana.

Funds for the new stone paths on #'s 7 & 14 were donated by the MGA.

The MGA is also providing the funds to clean up, line and rock the areas around the ball washers.

Golf Committee, Rob Dunn.

Fairways and tees were aerified starting May 10. Insect treatment was done in May. Tree work is continuing, and stumps are to be ground and chipped. Divot filling was done by the Northwood Golf Team.

Cart entry and exit points are to be moved more often.

A Glo Ball Tournament has been suggested for late September during the full moon.

General Manager, Scott Carter.

BOG elections are complete. Results will be posted shortly.

The pool will open May 29. The canopy is to be put up and a pump replaced. A speaker is to be installed in the Nineteenth Hole.

Wi-Fi is set up downstairs.

The balcony is to be spruced up in the future.

Activity Manager candidates are being interviewed. This person will be responsible for member and guest events.

Golf Update, Robert Dugger.
